We are so excited to share the news! The Maine Support Network has been awarded multiple grants by the MDOE to support educators throughout the state by identifying and providing access to relevant and effective Open Educational Resources (OERs) in the following areas:

- Math
- Health and Physical Education
- World Languages
- Career Prep

As a result of this exciting news, **we are looking for Maine educators**, who are leaders in these content fields, for *short-term* work on these Title II-D research grants.

We are currently seeking team leaders and teacher researchers who are (1) leaders in these content areas, (2) have expertise in using learning structures that engage all learners, and (3) are experienced with online resources and the use of technology to promote learning. Teacher leaders will support small teams of regional teacher researchers (1 per region) within the identified content area. Teacher researchers will work with the other members of their teams to identify OERs in their content areas that will benefit Maine teachers and students in achieving Maine's Learning Results. Each content-area team will identify OERs that promote effective teaching strategies in that area and allow teachers to have, at their finger tips, access to resources that promote effective learning strategies, and activities that lead to deep, connected, and rich learning opportunities.
